Dear Parents,

We are excited to start another school year. We will be having a special parent-child orientation on **Tuesday**, **August 29th** from **11-11:45**. This will be an opportunity for parents and children to tour the classroom together, explore the playground and meet your child's teachers and classmates. Your child's <u>first day of school will be Tuesday</u>, <u>September 5<sup>th</sup></u>, <u>when the children come for only two and a half hours</u> from **8:40** to **11:10**. Your child's <u>second day of school</u>, <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>September 6th</u>, we will begin the regular class times: <u>8:40 - 12</u>. Kindergarten will be dropped off at the south entrance to the building but will be picked up at our main playground. When dropping off, please avoid backing up to Broadway. If there are several cars in front of you, please circle through and return.

Beginning the second week of school (September 11<sup>th</sup>) and for the rest of the first semester, class will begin at 8:40 and end on Monday, Thursday, and Friday at 12:00, while on Tuesday and Wednesday it will extend until 2:00, and the children will bring a lunch. Starting the last week in January and throughout the rest of the second semester, Thursday will be added as a longer day, with dismissal at 2:00. (Please note that the dismissal time on the short days is staggered from the preschool dismissal time of 11:30 to help ease the traffic flow through the driveway.) Our schedule is for specials (Music, Spanish, and Art) to begin the week of September 11<sup>th</sup> as well.

The Kindergarten Class will be using our downstairs Kindergarten wing, and your child's Head Teacher is Ashleigh Smyth. This is Ashleigh's second year at The Acorn, having quickly become a favorite of the children and teaching staff alike. Ashleigh grew up in Zimbabwe and South Africa and received her BA in English and Psychology from Rhodes University, and her post Graduate Higher Diploma in Education from University of South Africa. She is married and has three grown sons and two daughters-in-law! She loves exploring trails, rivers, and lakes around San Antonio. With 26 years of prior teaching experience, Ashleigh devoted time this past spring shadowing in The Acorn's unique kindergarten in anticipation of her new role and we are so happy to have her. You will love Ashleigh's warm personality, happy enthusiasm, and lovely accent. Joining Ashleigh is Melonie Harrison as a Co-head teacher in training. This will be Mel's 11th year of teaching.
