

<p align="center">The Acorn Summer Camps 2025 Two 2-Week Sessions: June 2-13; June 16-27</p>

Summer sessions at the Acorn are a fun experience! Sign up now for a fun start to summer. There is a \$150 enrollment fee per child, per session, due at the time of enrollment. Tuition per child, per session, will be an additional \$300, and will be due on the first day of class. Payments can be made by cash, check, or credit card. If paying by credit card, there is a 4% credit card transaction fee that will be applied. Once paid, enrollment fees and tuition are non-refundable.

We will dress up, build puppet sets, and create artwork inspired by storytelling.

	Famous Trios Older Preschoolers, Next Year's & Graduating Kindergartners Come along as we explore the number 3 in many of our favorite stories! We will dive into the pages of The Three Little Pigs, Goldilocks and the Three Bears, and The Three Billy Goats Gruff-acting out the stories, creating alternative versions, and testing concepts from bridge building to chair construction while listening to musical trios! FUN, FUN, FUN!		
	A Circus of Color Science Preschoolers Our science laboratory will have us exploring with color as we experiment our way through this two-week session. We will create colorful volcanoes, blend colors in "magic milk, watch how color "walks" with the help of water, and create color changing flowers. We will use prisms and bubbles to learn about refraction. We will ask and answer questions about how color plays an important role in design by creating a circus using our color ideas for things from costumes to the big top!
